Our mission is to help you discover the information you need to follow the work of the Faroese Parliamentserve. We wrote this policy to help you understand what information we collect, how we use it and what choices you have about it. If you have any feedback or concerns, we welcome your questions and comments on this policy.

We collect information in a few different ways:

1. When you give it to us or give us permission to obtain it

Signup When you as a member of the Parliament sign up for or use Logting, you give us certain information voluntarily. This includes your name, email address, profile photo and birthday

2. We also get device information when you use Logting

We collect information about the ipad you're using Logting on, including type of device, operating system, and crash data that helps us understand when something breaks. This information is collected anonymously, it's not connected to your account in any way. Whether we collect some or all of this information often depends on what type of device you're using and its settings. To learn more about what information your device makes available to us, please also check the policies of your device manufacturer or software provider.

What we do with the info we collect:

We use the information we collect to provide the Service to you. We only show you material, that is of relevance to you.

In addition and for similar reasons, we have a legitimate interest in using your information in these ways. It is also fundamental to the nature of the Service we provide. In short, it's necessary for us to do these things in order to make the Service relevant, interesting and personal to you. In addition to the specific circumstances above, we'll only use your information with your consent in order to: Send you materials by email, text or push notification, depending on your account or operating system settings. Each time we send you materials, we give you the option to unsubscribe.

Transferring your information:

Logting is a service, used by all members of the Faroese parliament. By using Logting, you authorize us to transfer and store your information outside your home country to our partners, based on a confidentiality agreement which assures the security of your data and the use of it will be according with the EU regulations. We take additional measures when information is transferred from the European Economic Area (EEA).

Choices you have about your info:

Our goal is to give you simple and meaningful choices regarding your information. If you have a **Logting account**, many of the choices you have are built directly into your settings. You also have choices available to you **through the Ipad** you use to access Løgting.

How and when we share your information:

Our partners provide you content through Logting.

How long we keep your information:

We keep your information only for so long as we need it to provide Løgting services to you and fulfill the purposes described in this policy. This is also the case for anyone that we share your information with and who carries out services on our behalf. When we no longer need to use your information and there is no need for us to keep it to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, we'll either remove it from our systems or depersonalize it so that we can't identify you.

How we make changes to this policy:

We may change this policy from time to time and if we do, we'll post any changes on this page. If you continue to use Løgting after those changes are in effect, you agree to the new policy. If the changes are significant, we may provide a more prominent notice or get your consent, as required by law.
